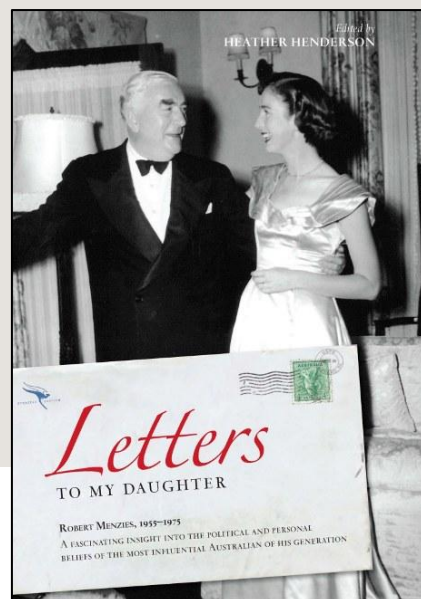
AUTHOR PROFILE
